8.45-10.15am in the school hall.

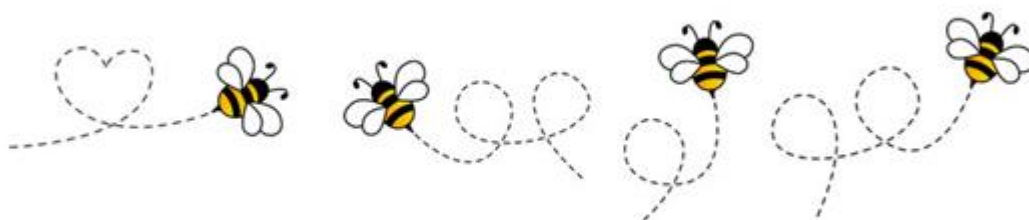
