Our Curriculum

Our exciting curriculum is divided in to three terms:

Autumn Term 1: Revolutionary Romans - learning about what the Romans did to help Britain

Autumn Term 2: Romans Rule - looking at the Roman rules and the impact they had on us today

Spring Term 1: Shining a light into the ancient tombs - combining our science and history learning about electricity and light with the Ancient Egyptians

Spring Term 2: Sound inventions - our science focus learning about sound and continuing to learn about some of the Ancient Egyptian inventions

Summer Term 1: The Circle of Life - a science and geography focus into animals and their habitats and the water cycle

Summer Term 2: Brilliant Bodies - a science focus learning about the inside of our bodies
