8.45-10.15am in the school hall.

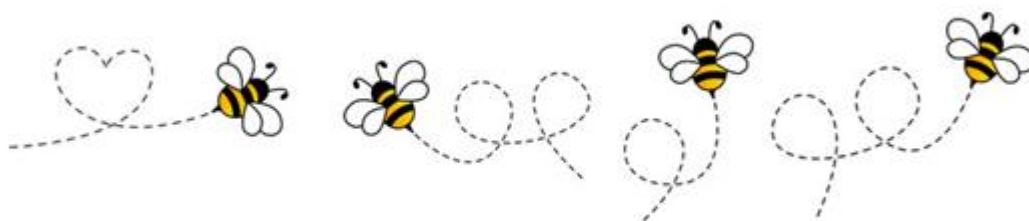
Mrs Marshall looks forward to seeing some familiar faces and hopefully welcoming some our parents that are new to High View.
