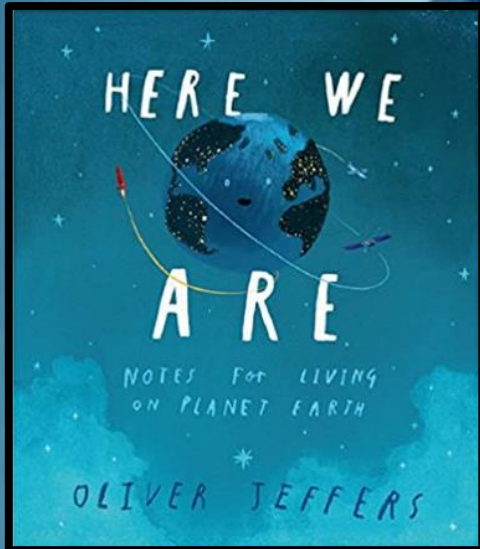

## Maths Ideas

- <https://www.visnos.com/demos/clock> Click on the button that says 'real time' Children to get a 'feel' for how long a minute is by waiting 60 seconds. Does it feel like a long time? What can you do in 1 minute? For example, how many times can you walk around the room? Can you build a tower in 1 minute? How many times can you sing Twinkle Twinkle in 1 minute?
- Use the clock again, click on the button that says real time <https://www.visnos.com/demos/clock>, this time consider how long 2 minutes is. What could you do in 2 minutes? How many times can you write your name in 2 minutes? How many playdough worms can you make in 2 minutes?
- Time challenge. Using the clock from yesterday or a phone timer, time how long it takes to count to 10/50/100. See if you can beat your time. Time how long it takes to do various things, e.g. walk to door and back, write your name 10 times, jump 30 times.
- Test your maths skills by completing the number block quiz <https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/puzzles/numberblocks-number-magic-quiz-level-1> If you are ready you can move onto level 2 and even level 3!
