Foundation parents to then go through the open door which will be signposted, walk outside down the path where another door will be open and signposted. Please wait in the corridor and your child's teacher will invite you into the classroom when they are available.

Key Stage 1, leave the reception area through the open door at the bottom of Y3 and Y4 doors and go to your child's classroom just as you would to drop off on a morning. Your child's work will be on the classroom table for you to look at.

- **FS2** Drop off time (morning) This will take place in the school hall.


